



AMS Summer Assembly-in-Brief

Please note: Assembly-in-Brief is not a substitute for the official minutes or agenda. It serves to summarize some key information for members of assembly and members at large.

As per the AMS Constitution, "The Executive and such members of the Council as are present shall have the delegated powers of the Assembly during the spring and summer terms (Summer Assembly)... no decision of the Council which is made under the authority of the delegated powers from the Assembly shall continue to stand unless reaffirmed by the Assembly"

As such, the following substantive policy changes made by Summer Assembly are subject to ratification at Assembly in the fall.

Motions

- 1. That Summer Assembly approve the agenda for the Assembly meeting of March 20th, 2014.**

**Motion carried unanimously*

- 2. That Summer Assembly approve the amendments to Policy Manual II, Section 8 as seen in Appendix A: CES Policy Updates.**

President Allison Williams explained the policy changes included in the motion. Significant changes include allowing interns to be eligible to hold part-time service positions and changing language around eligibility of positions to offer internship opportunities. There was some debate regarding if interns should receive honoraria.
